Official rules for 2021

For those interested in submitting their art:

This exhibition is open to all professional, amateur and student artists, photographers, and sculptors. Anyone interested in providing a sculpture must contact the Friends of Wallisch for display parameters through their email address wallischhomestead@gmail.com. Subject matter must be in good taste, non-political, appropriate for all ages and contain no advertising. If you have any questions about your entry's appropriateness please contact The Friends of Wallisch Homestead. The WHOA committee will judge the acceptability of subject matter for presentation and their determination will be final.

A registration fee of \$25 per artist is required (applicants under 19 years of age \$15). Entries are limited to 3 pieces per artist. Pre-registration is required. Registration closes on May 1st.

If an artist chooses to have their piece for sale, and it sells, a commission of 20% will be collected by the Friends of Wallisch Homestead.

Awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place, and honorable mention in each of the following categories:

- Acrylic
- Drawing
- Oil
- Pastel
- Water color
- Mixed Media
- Sculpture
- Photography - People
- Photography - Places
- Photography - Things
- Artist age 12 and under
- Artist age 13 through 18

Entries will also be judged for "Best In Show".

Entrants under the age of 19 can elect to have an entry judged EITHER in their age category OR in any of the specific media categories as an adult. If an artist chooses to be judged in the adult category, the \$25 fee applies.

A group of judges will select the winners in each category and their determination will be final.

There will be a special Wallisch Homestead Award for best piece depicting the Wallisch Homestead.

A People's Choice Award will be voted on by the public and will be presented at the end of the day on the 23rd.

All entries **must** be securely mounted and wired for hanging. There will be a \$10 wiring fee if entries are **not** securely wired. No alligator teeth or clips. No exceptions. All entries **must** be labeled with the completed labels provided on the Friends of Wallisch Homestead website at www.wallischhomestead.org.

Receiving day for all entries will be Saturday May 15th from 10AM-2PM in the barn at the Wallisch Homestead, 65 Lincoln Avenue, West Milford, NJ.

Pick-up will be on last day of showing, May 23rd from 3PM to 4PM. If you are unable to pick up your work during this timeframe, please make arrangements for someone else to do it for you. Friends of Wallisch Homestead cannot be responsible for any work left beyond the last day of the show.

All submissions will be handled with reasonable care. The Friends of Wallisch Homestead and any volunteers shall not be responsible for damage, loss or theft. Submitting an entry in this exhibition implies agreement on the part of the photographer, artist, or sculptor with all of the conditions outlined in this prospectus. Winning entries will be posted on the Friends of Wallisch Homestead website in non-reproducible form.
